Meeting information note

How to get to Madrid

Madrid international airport is Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport (IATA code: MAD; OACI code: LEMD). Madrid city can be reached from the airport by taxi, metro, train or bus.

Taxi. The price for a taxi ride from the Madrid-Barajas airport to the centre of Madrid is a flat rate € 30 one way. Referring to the taxis basic fare table, this rate is "Fixed airport Rate 4". Metro. There is a metro line from Madrid city to the airport terminal 4: Metro Line 8 Nuevos Ministerios - Aeropuerto T4. The line has two metro stations in the airport: "Aeropuerto T1 T2 T3" and "Aeropuerto T4". Between these two stations, there is a metro station called "Barajas" that is not in the airport. Metro Line 8 operates from 6.05 am (morning) to 1.30 am (night). The route to the airport since the beginning of the line 8 takes 13/15 minutes to the T1-T2-T3 metro station (first stop at the airport), and takes 5 minutes more until the second metro station at the airport (the last stop), at the terminal 4. The fare of the ticket to the airport belongs to the *Special Service* tariff. See <https://www.aeropuertomadrid-barajas.com/transportation/madrid-airport-bymetro.htm> for more details.

Train. The Spanish railway company RENFE connects Madrid with Madrid-Barajas Airport through the local train network service "Cercanías" C1 and C10 lines. The train station is on the terminal 4 floor -1, and is called Aeropuerto T4. To move to the other terminals there is a shuttle bus service connecting the terminals. Single ticket tariff is 2,60 €, valid for one journey in the two hours after it is issued. See <https://www.aeropuertomadrid-barajas.com/transportation/madrid-airport-bytrain.htm> for more details.

Bus. Intercity bus lines 822, 824, 827 and 828 connect the airport with other towns. See <https://www.aeropuertomadrid-barajas.com/transportation/madrid-airport-bybus.htm> for more details.

- Cercanías (local train): station Madrid-Atocha
- Bus: lines 001, 6, 10, 14, 19, 26, 27, 32, 34, 37, 45, C03, N9, N10, N11, N12, N13, N14, N15, N17, N25, N26
