- In 2014, the Strategic Working Group on Forestry was established (First mandate period (2014-2016)
- In 2016 the group refocused its mandate (2016-2018).

SWG FOREST

- Aim at strengthening coordination of Forest Research and Innovation between the EU, Member States and Stakeholders for the development of a coherent and ambitious EU forest-based research area that is able to meet the challenges of forest adaptation to, and mitigation of climate changes
- Focus on **forest-based systems**, **products and services**; it interacts with other SCAR groups (Bioeconomy), forest-relevant Era-Nets and European platforms and networks (FTP, EFI, etc.)
- Propose to renew its mandate for the period 2018-2020 with new terms of reference and widened participation from MS



Specific objectives of SCAR FOREST include:

- promote forest-based systems and value-chain approaches with due considerations of synergies and interrelations with other sectors;
- provide strategic intelligence by mapping national forest R&I capacities, policies, strategies;
- engage in knowledge-based input to public debates on forest-related EU policy areas and global issues (climate change, water, bioenergy, biodiversity, plant health, trade, etc.);
- advise on R&I support to the implementation of national forestry policies and the EU Forest Strategy.



Workpackages

1 FOREST BIOECONOMY

- ► Tasks: mapping, analysis and synthesis on forest-based bioeconomy research and innovation (R&I) in Europe.
- Deliverable: report "Synthesis on forest bioeconomy research and innovation in Europe"

2 TRANSNATIONAL COLLABORATION

- ► Tasks: assessment of forest-related ERA-NETs and COST actions, identification of future areas and topics for joint programming and alignment of research activities.
- Deliverables: report from expert study (February 2018), EU workshop (second term, 2018)

3 INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

► Tasks: mapping of international forest related scientific cooperation, identification of key areas for future development






Comparison of research capacities and EC's funding by region




EC's funding by region and category






Collaboration between countries in Forest systems
