They are called to contribute to the organization of the Italian research and to define objectives, methodologies and tools

In 2001 Interregional network for agricultural, forestry, aquaculture and fisheries research was established. Reaching today 16 Regions and 2 autonomous Provinces coordinated by Tuscany

The need: create a link between all Regions/autonomus Provinces for working together also in relationships with the Italian Ministry of Agriculture, Food and Forestry (MiPAAF) and Ministry of University and Research (MiUR) The Network is composed by regional representatives that implement program on research and innovation (managers, technicians, policy officers)



The purpose of the network

Identify and define the innovation needs in their territories


Create synergies between regions to address common issues and solve common problems

Participate jointly to the definition of innovation needs and strategies at national and European level


Until 2013 Regions edited themselves a common document on strategic research goals organized for value chain and transversal themes, updated every three years

MiPAAF, in agreement with the Regions, promoted during 2013/2014 a process of coordination that led to the drafting of the important governance tool called "Strategic Plan for Innovation and research in the agricultural, food and forestry sectors - **PSIR**"



The interregional network participates in the definition of the National Rural Network programs regarding innovation



Many regions participating in the italian interregional network are also part of ERIAFF -*European Region for Innovation in Agriculture, Food and Forestry*

ERIAFF is an informal network.



Activities are selected and operated on the basis of joint interests and/or strong commitment from one or more of its members.

ERIAFF has attracted a growing number of partners, reaching today 71 Regions (41 members and 30 observers) Interregional network for agricultural, forestry, aquaculture and fisheries research

Aims for the future

- Strengthen collaboration with the Italian Ministry of Agriculture to identify common strategies and goals
- More integration and interaction with other policies (research, industry, environment, etc.)
- Increase interaction with SCAR, European networks, EIP-AGRI, etc.
- More interaction with Agriculture Knowledge and Innovation Systems
